1. Please ensure that all details are correct, as information on this card will be used for registration in Parish records.
2. Use **BLOCK CAPITALS** throughout.
3. Please indicate whether you want the baptism listed in the next Parish Newsleeter or not.
4. Give all names in full (i.e. **all** forenames and surname).
5. Mothers please be sure and list your Maiden not Married Name.
6. Baptisms take place in:
 - St Columb's Church, Chapel Rd. on **SATURDAYS** at **4pm**.
 - Immaculate Conception Church, Trench Road on **SUNDAYS** at **1pm**.
 - St Oliver's Church, Strathfoyle on **SATURDAYS** at **5pm**.
 - St Mary's Oratory, Newbuildings **BY ARRANGEMENT**.
7. Please bring the Baptismal Robe and Baptismal Candle to the ceremony.
8. This card, duly completed, should be handed in at the Parochial Office/House at least **ONE WEEK** before the date of the Baptism.
9. The Parish Baptismal Team will then arrange a visit to you prior to the Baptism.
10. A Godparent must be a baptised and confirmed Catholic who lives a life of faith which befits the role to be undertaken, be at least 16 years of age, and, if there are two Godparents, one must be male and one female. (Canons 873 & 874).
11. If the child has been baptised in danger of death, do not complete this card, but, instead, arrange with one of the priests for the ceremony of bringing the already baptised child to the church.
